



# Home Learning Hedgehog Class ~ Autumn 1

## Maths

Go on a number hunt in your home or on a walk – can you spot numbers on doors, buses, or signs?

Count the conkers, leaves or acorns you collect. Can you sort them into groups of 5 or 10?

Play a board game with dice – can you count the spaces carefully?

Sing your favourite counting song. Can you make up a new verse?

## The World About

Go for an Autumn walk – what changes can you see in the trees and weather?

Try some simple cooking with an adult – maybe make apple crumble or pumpkin soup!

Talk about the animals that you might see in Autumn. Where do hedgehogs go?

Send a photo of your family/people who are special to you

Our key focus is your reading homework – please try to read **AT LEAST** 3 times a week. The other activities will help with your topic learning and you will earn dojo points. You can choose which activities you find the most interesting...or you can do them all! Upload photos, videos or voice recordings to your profile on Class Dojo and we will look at them at the end of each half term. 10 dojos for each activity completed!

## \* Reading \*

The children will always have a reading book to bring home. The children should be reading at least 3 times a week, thinking about sounding out the words but also trying to understand what they are reading. This will be checked every Friday and dojos will be awarded!

## Play and Leisure

What is your favourite game to play at home?

Practise gross motor skills by throwing, catching and kicking.

## English

What is your favourite Autumn story? Share this with an adult, or bring it in to share with your friends.

Go on a word hunt – how many signs, labels or words can you spot when you are out and about?

Practise retelling a story using puppets, toys, or pictures.

## Independence

Explore different types of fasteners: Buckles, buttons, zips, press-studs, Velcro and laces. Which have you mastered?

## CREATIVE

Collect some autumn leaves and use them to make leaf rubbings or prints.

Create a picture of a hedgehog using natural materials (sticks, leaves, conkers).

Build a model using junk materials (boxes, tubes, pots). What will you make?
